The world's most streamlined horn frame

LINDBERG, Royal Warrant holding purveyor to the Danish Court and winner of 77 international design awards, has now presented a buffalo horn frame that the world has never seen before.

"When I showed my design team the prototype made of finely scraped acetate, and told them, that I wanted to represent exactly the same luxurious touch on buffalo horn, they all immediately responded that they were not able to create it." Henrik laughed.

The screw less Air Titanium frame gives wearers a feeling of wearing only air, just as its name suggests. This is the reason why LINDBERG is regarded a unique mindset that has revolutionized the eyewear business.



The collection is made from extremely thin slices of buffalo horn in a combination with lightweight, flexible and strong titanium, normally used for production of medical implants. The nose pads are formed with a kind of silicone which is also widely used on medical devices. ¥133,000

Many times of trials and errors have created a design featuring 3 thin layers of buffalo horn, which gives the frame not only strength and stability but also visually pleasing gradation.
